## Advanced Placement Score Analysis

Advanced Placement Exams are scored on a scale from one to five. Scores of three, four, and five are considered passing grades and are awarded college credit by most colleges and universities in the United States. In the spring of 2014, 164 St. Francis de Sales students took 360 AP Exams. The school as a whole passed 75% of the examinations. The national passing rate is 59.9%. 124 of the 164 examinees received a passing grade on at least one AP exam (76% of total). In 2013 the passing rate was 65%.

## Academic Initiatives for the 2014-15 School Year

### 1. New Courses for the 2014-15 Academic Year

Computer and Academic Skills (Grades 9, Computer Science, required for all freshmen)

Art 3 Independent Study (Grades 11-12, Fine Arts, elective)

2. **World Geography** (1 semester, 0.50 credits) is now a requirement for all freshmen
3. **Freshmen Mentoring Director** is a new position that oversees the mentoring program and works to increase retention among students in the freshman class.
4. Xavier University approved the SFS Latin III and AP Latin courses for **dual enrollment**. Thus SFS students who successfully complete these two courses will receive college credit for a minimal fee.
5. An **exchange with St. Michel High School in Annecy, France** is now established. St. Michel students travelled to SFS this past spring for two weeks of home-stay, classes, and excursions. SFS students will travel to St. Michel in November 2014. This kind of exchange program promotes interest and enthusiasm and ultimately greater confidence and proficiency in language study.
