Overview and Notes

SFS College Credit Programs

SFS Juniors and Seniors have the opportunity to earn college credit by participating in one or more of our three College Credit Programs. The three programs are Advanced Placement (AP), Dual Enrollment (DeSales University), or College Credit Plus (CCP). Students can participate in our AP and Dual Enrollment Programs by selecting AP courses during our normal course registration process (by far, most of the college credit earned by our students is through our AP Program). **Students and parents wishing to participate in CCP, however, must act before regular SFS registration and adhere to several important deadlines.** Please review the CCP material included here if interested in participating in the CCP Program for next school year.

CCP History

College Credit Plus was introduced at the beginning of the 2015-2016 school year. It is a state-wide program that offers qualified Ohio students the opportunity to simultaneously earn high school and college credit for college-level courses. Through the CCP program, students may enroll in **Introduction to Engineering, Introduction to Business, Introduction to Health Careers** or may take other on-line or on-campus course offerings.

Funding

These classes are funded by the state, for students who meet the requirements and who live in Ohio. Funding is not guaranteed, and may be limited, for those who apply.

Cautions

The grades the students earn will be part of their college transcript. A low grade could adversely affect the student's academic standing and/or acceptance into a college after high school graduation. In addition, if a student fails the class or drops the class after the withdrawal period has ended, the student (parents) will be responsible for payment of full tuition for the class.

The three introduction classes we are offering through UT are not guaranteed to transfer to another post-secondary institution.

Organization of Information

Parents will be asked to create usernames and passwords for the state's OH|ID account – and students will be asked to create usernames and passwords for several UT accounts. Students will also be assigned ID numbers from UT and the ODE. SFS does not have access to the log-in information or ID numbers and so will not be able to help if the student or parent forgets or loses this information.

SFS will ask students for the letters they receive from the state – especially the Funding Approval Notification. We need this information to help students register for classes. The state does not give SFS this information – so we need it from you.

Other Notes

Some students are ready, academically, to take college level classes, but are not self-disciplined enough to handle the other demands associated with college level coursework. Because there can be significant academic and financial consequences for poor performance and/or lack of responsibility, please carefully consider whether your son is ready.

Review how to apply for funding and participation in College Credit Plus!

FUNDING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Starting in February, a parent must create a OH ID Account (if you don't already have one) at https://ohid.ohio.gov Once the parent has a OH ID account, follow the online directions for requesting access to the College Credit Plus funding application. Once access to the funding application is granted, complete the Intent to Participate Section before April 1, 2023. The Intent to Participate Form is part of the online funding application. There will be no separate paper form. Complete each section of the funding application & upload the required documents in the parent's OH ID account. SUBMIT the application before the April 1, 2023 deadline! No exceptions & no extensions to the deadline are available. You will receive an email confirmation that you have successfully submitted the application. Each year, Ohio Department of Education processes funding applications and awards credits to students based on grade level. State funding is limited, and credit requests are not always fully funded. Within a few weeks, parents will receive an email notification that the funding award letter is available. Follow the instructions to log-in to OH ID account and download the funding letter. Provide that letter to your college. The application process will begin in February 2023 for the 2023-2024 school year Remember: The deadline is April 1, 2023 at 5 p.m. EST
PARTICIPATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Start early! Check with your preferred university or college for their deadlines. You must have an acceptance letter to submit with your funding application. Take the ACT or SAT, if required, early enough to meet deadlines. Allow at least 6 weeks for your results to be sent to the college or university. Apply to the college or university and submit any required documents (e.g., transcript, ACT scores). If the college or university requires Accuplacer, ALEKS, or Maplesoft T.A., PlaceU, or institutional exam, request a testing date. The college or university will determine your eligibility based on state and institutional requirements. If you are eligible and the college has accepted your application, you will receive an acceptance letter. Once accepted and after you receive your funding award letter, meet with the university or college's College Credit Plus advisor to discuss courses for which you are eligible to take. Provide a copy of your funding award letter to the advisor or other office as instructed.
